Mathematical	Numbers
Development	Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10.  Counts out up to six objects from a larger group.  Selects the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5, then 1 to 20objects.  Counts an irregular arrangement of up to ten objects.  Finds the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them.  Use the language of 'more' and 'fewer' to compare two sets of objects.  Says the number that is one more than a given number.  Finds one more or one less from a group of up to five objects, ten objects then twenty objects.  In practical activities and discussion, beginning to use the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting.  Records, using marks that they can interpret and explain.  Begins to identify own mathematical problems based on own interests and fascinations.
