Cleaner – Measuring cleaning liquids (ml/l)

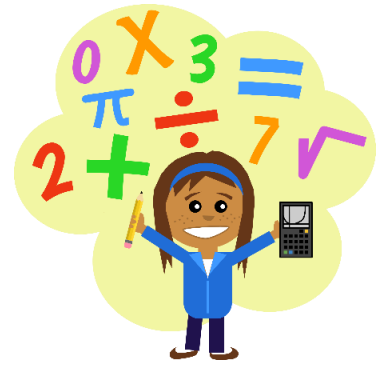
Chef – Weight (g and kg),
