Historical Knowledge		Constructing the past: Remembers parts of stories and memories about the past. Sequencing the past: Sequence some events or 2 related objects in order of time — up to 100 years (intervals of 10).	Sequencing the past: Uses words and phrases: old, new, young, days, months, nowadays, in the past and previously to show knowledge of time.
History Concepts	Change and development: Tell the difference between past and present in own and other people's lives.	Cause and effects: Begins to identify and recount some details from the past from sources (e.g. pictures, stories). Study the lives of significant individuals who contributed to national and international achievements.
