Communication and language — Listen to the story — Stick man	Personal, social and emotional development- Talk about the story Stick man. About his family and how much he loved and missed them. See if your child can name who is in their family. With younger children, you may need ask them who lives in their house, and support them with the answer.	Physical Development — Using a large ball, if you have one or a small one if not. See if your child can gently throw the ball and catch it again. Maybe try throwing it to each other gently.	Communication and language — Look at pictures of Christmas trees and decorations that you can put on them. If your tree is up, you can carefully look at the decorations you have on your tree. Talk about the colours of them and describe them e.g. Shiny, sparkly etc	Personal, social and emotional development- Using a tray or shallow tub. Fill with cotton wool balls or pleats, add any safe sparkly items you have. You can also add the sticks that you used for counting, small world people if you have any and then allow your child to play freely.

Understanding the World - When you go out for a walk, see if you can collect some sticks. You will need around 7 – 10. You can now help your child make a stick man of their very own.	Creative — Encourage your child to draw a picture of their family. Don't worry if it's just marks on paper. Ask 'Who is that?' For younger children use large pieces of paper, cello taped together if needed.	Maths- With the extra sticks that you collected, use them for counting. Encourage your child to line them up and count out loud. Give support when needed.	Physical Development – Make a salt dough, Christmas tree decoration.	Creative — After leaving your salt dough decoration to dry overnight. Now paint your dough. Allow your child to be involved in deciding what colours to choose.
