What's that? Where is?).</li> <li>Speaking</li> <li>+ (16-26 months) Beginning to ask simple questions.</li> <li>+ (22-36 months) Learns new words very rapidly and is able to use them in communicating.</li> </ul>
Physical Development	<ul> <li>Moving &amp; handling</li> <li>+ (16-26 months) Makes connections between their movement and the marks they make.</li> <li>+ (22-36 months) May be beginning to show preference for dominant hand.</li> </ul>
Literacy	Reading  + (16-26 months) Interested in books and rhymes and may have favourites.  + (22-36 months) Has some favourite stories, rhymes, songs, poems or jingles.

Mathematics	<ul> <li>Numbers</li> <li>+ (16-26 months) Says some counting words randomly.</li> <li>+ (22-36 months) Recites some number names in sequence.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Shape, space &amp; measure</li> <li>+ (16-26 months) Enjoys filling and emptying containers.</li> <li>+ (22-36 months) Beginning to categorise objects according to properties such as shape or size.</li> </ul>
Understanding the world	<ul> <li>The world</li> <li>→ (16-26 months) Explores objects by linking together different approaches: shaking, hitting, looking, feeling, tasting, mouthing, pulling, turning and poking.</li> <li>→ (22-36 months) Notices detailed features of objects in their environment.</li> </ul>
Expressive arts and design	Being imaginative  → (16-26 months) Notices and is interested in the effects of making movements which leave marks.  → (22-36 months) Experiments with blocks, colours and marks
