


Read the Chinese new year story to the children.





<p>Using marbles, peddles, coins or any items that will make a sound when dropped-play the counting game.</p> <p>Ask your child to close their eyes as you slowly drop marbles into a metal jug or jar. As you child to use their fingers to help them to count in their head how many have been dropped into the jar. Open eyes, check on fingers and write down the number to show how many. Check answer by counting the actual amount that was dropped.</p> <p>Repeat several times and then let your child take the turn of being the marble dropper for you!</p> 	<p>EYO Numbers: Recites numbers in order to 12.</p> <p>Use ordinal number language</p>  <p>Recap on the PowerPoint that was shared with the children in the yesterday.</p> <p>Show the children the animal cards with the ordinal numbers. Introduce the children to the language of ordinal numbers, 1st, 2nd, 3rdetc.</p> <p>Children make number line using the correct sequence of the story.</p>	<p>EYO Numbers: Recites numbers in order to 12.</p> <p>Use ordinal number language.</p>  <p>Line up all the animals in the story – count how many there are.
