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<b>Continuous provision idea</b> Draw basic dinosaur foot prints onto a piece of paper. In each foot printer write a number from 0-10 or 20 if you know your child can recognise up to this number. You may wish to use blocks, cubes or teddies as a resource of counting. Encourage your child to recognise the number and place the correct amount of objects onto the number.	<b>Continuous provision idea</b> You may wish to encourage your child to move around like a dinosaur, encourage them to use their voice to make the sound of the dinosaur. Ask your child if they can stomp like a dinosaur, e.t.c.
<b>Rhyming Time</b> If your child has instruments at home, they may wish to use these OR they may wish to use actions such as claps, stomps, clicks.	<b>Story Time</b> You may wish to encourage your child to choose a story of their choice OR if you have any dinosaur/animal stories then read this to your child. Encourage them to turn the pages for you.
