Chronological Understanding	 Uses timelines to place events in order (intervals of 10/100) Understands timeline can be divided into BC and AD. Uses words and phrases: century, decade. 		
Historical Knowledge	 Uses evidence to describe past: houses and settlements, culture and leisure activities, clothes, way of life and actions of people, buildings and their uses. People's beliefs and attitudes and things of importance to people. Differences between lives of rich and poor. Describes similarities and differences between people, events and objects. 		
Historical Interpretation	o Looks at two versions of same event and identifies differences in the accounts.		
Historical Enquiry	 Uses printed sources, the internet, pictures, photos, music, artefacts, historic buildings and visits to collect information about the past. Asks questions such as 'How did people? What did people do for?' Suggests sources of evidence to use to help answer questions.
