Homework, Spellings & Reading

Year 1 - Year 6

Homework and Spelling will be sent home from next week. It is essential that we work together to support our children in completing homework tasks. A consistency in approach will support learning.

Homework: will be given to children (in a homework book) on a Friday afternoon and is expected to be returned by Tuesday of the following week. Please note that time will be made available on a Monday for teachers to clarify any misconceptions that the children may have.

A Dojo message will be sent by the class teacher informing parents and carers of the homework tasks set.

Spellings: Will be given to children on a Monday to learn for their weekly spellings on a Friday.

Reading books and records: These will be sent home today for Year 3, 45 & 6. We ask for these to be brought into school every day. The class teacher will monitor these frequently and children will be listened to read on a regular basis.

Year 1 &2 will be sent home with a Read to Me book each Friday (starting today) for you to read and discuss together. We would ask for these to be returned each Friday so that they can be changed.
