**Re: Liverpool School Street Project – ANPR Camera Enforcement  
School: St Cuthbert Primary School**

I'm writing to update you on the Liverpool School Street Project, following the recent consultation that was carried out to introduce a timed access restriction on Church Road.

I am happy to inform you that we received majority support for this scheme and this project is moving forward. ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) camera enforcement will begin on **4th November 2024**. Any vehicle that enters the road during the operational times may receive a Penalty Charge Notice of £70.

**When Will Enforcement Apply?**

The enforcement will apply only during school opening and closing times for St Cuthbert's Catholic Primary School. The operational hours are:

**8:15am–9:15am** and **2:30pm–3:30pm** (during school term only).

Permanent Signage will be erected on site shortly which will detail the operational times of the access restriction as this needs to be in place prior to any enforcement being carried out.

Temporary signage will also be installed on site to further notify drivers that enforcement begins on 4<sup>th</sup> November 2024.

**What This Means for You**

- Parents and guardians will not be allowed to drive into this road for school drop off or pick up during the operational hours.

**Exemptions**

If you regularly drop off or pick up children and you have a Blue Badge or dropping off/ picking up Special Educational Needs children, then you can apply for an exemption.

To do this, you will need to apply to the school with your details. Once they have approved your application they will send us your details.
