Ascension Day is when we celebrate Jesus' return to his Father in Heaven.</p> <p><b>PENTECOST SUNDAY – 8<sup>th</sup> June</b>            This is the day we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the Church.</p> <p><b>THE MOST HOLY TRINITY – 15<sup>th</sup> June</b>            Today we celebrate our belief in the Trinity, the three persons of God: The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.</p> <p><b>THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI – 19<sup>th</sup> June</b>            On this feast we give thanks to God for the gift of Jesus in the form of bread and wine.</p> <p><b>THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS – 27<sup>th</sup> June</b>            On this day we remember how much Jesus loves us all.</p> <p><b>SS.
