- ✓ Our Year 5 & Year 6 athletes represented us magnificently in the Indoor Athletics City Final. They were exceptional ambassadors for our school; they gave their absolute all, competing with pride and determination. – we are so proud of them!
- ✓ Anthony Walker Foundation delivered impactful and thought-provoking anti-racism assemblies to our Key Stage 2 children this week. The sessions focused on promoting kindness, compassion, and community, educating our young people on celebrating diversity, tackling hate crime, and fostering positive, respectful relationships from a young age. Our facilitator took the time to email me after the sessions and shared, *'Your children were amazing and such deep thinkers. It was an absolute pleasure to work with them.'*

Sessions focused on our children knowing their place and feeling part of our environment which is a basic human need.
