Please ensure that your child brings a labelled water bottle to school and that it contains water only. Children will be encouraged to refill their bottles through the school day.

Children in Early Years, Year 1 & Year 2 have fruit provided for them daily. Children in Year 3-6 are invited to bring a fruit snack with them to school each day. All classes will integrate snack time into their morning routine.

Hydration and nutrition are essential building blocks for a child's cognitive development, directly shaping how they focus, process information, and learn throughout the school day. When children regularly drink water and consume fresh fruit, they are providing their brains with the precise fuel needed for optimal daily academic performance.
